2	<p><b>Worship and serve God</b>  <b>Matthew 4:10</b> Then saith Jesus unto him, <b>Get you hence, Satan: for it is written, You shalt worship Yahweh your God, and Him only shalt you serve.</b> (Luk 4:8)</p>	<p><b>Deuteronomy 6:13</b> You shalt fear Yahweh your God, and serve Him, and shalt swear by His name. (Exo 12:31, 23:25; Deut 10:12, 20)</p>	<p><b>Psalm 29:2</b> Give unto Yahweh the glory due unto His name; worship Yahweh in the beauty of holiness. (Jos; 24:15; Psa 2:11, 96:9, 100:2; Isa 27:13; Jer 7:2)</p>
3	<p><b>Repent</b>  <b>Matthew 4:17</b> From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, <b>Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.</b> (Mark 1:15; Luke 13:3, Rev 2:10, 16, 3:19)</p>	<p>The OT makes it clear that repentance is a condition for escaping temporal judgment and premature death.</p> <p><b>temporal:</b> [adjective] of or relating to time as opposed to eternity. Of or relating to earthly life.</p>	<p><b>Job 42:6</b> Wherefore I abhor <i>myself</i>, and repent in dust and ashes.</p> <p><b>Isaiah 55:7</b> Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto Yahweh, and He will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon.</p> <p><b>Ezekiel 3:19</b> Yet if you warn the wicked, and he turn not from his wickedness, nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but you hast delivered your soul.</p> <p><b>Ezekiel 14:6</b> Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus saith Yahweh GOD; Repent, and turn <i>yourselves</i> from your idols; and turn away your faces from all your abominations. (18:30)</p> <p><b>Ezekiel 18:23</b> Have I any pleasure at all that the wicked should die? saith Yahweh GOD: <i>and</i> not that he should return from his ways, and live? (18:32, 33:11)</p>
4	<p><b>Follow Me</b>  <b>Matthew 4:19</b> And He saith unto them, <b>Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men.</b> (Matthew 8:22; Matthew 16:24; Mark 8:34; Mark 10:21; Luke 9:23; John 21:19)</p>	<p><b>Deuteronomy 6:5</b> And you shalt love Yahweh your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. (28:1-68)</p>	<p><b>Hosea 6:3</b> Then shall we know, <i>if</i> we follow on to know Yahweh: His going forth is prepared as the morning; and He shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter <i>and</i> former rain unto the earth.</p>
5	<p><b>Rejoice</b>  <b>Matthew 5:12</b> <b>Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.</b></p>	<p><b>Deuteronomy 12:7</b> And there you shall eat before Yahweh your God, and you shall rejoice in all that you put your hand unto, you and your households, wherein Yahweh your God hath blessed you.</p>	<p><b>1Chronicles 16:10</b> Glory ye in His holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek Yahweh.</p> <p><b>Psalm 20:5</b> We will rejoice in Your salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up <i>our</i> banners: Yahweh fulfil all your petitions.</p> <p><b>Psalm 35:9</b> And my soul shall be joyful in Yahweh: it shall rejoice in His salvation.</p> <p><b>Psalm 40:16</b> Let all those that seek You rejoice and be glad in You: let such as love Your salvation say continually,</p>

6	<p><b>Let your light shine/maintain good works</b>  <b>Matthew 5:16</b> Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.  <b>5:17</b> Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to perform them. (Luk 12:35)</p>	<p><b>Leviticus 19:18</b> ...but you shalt love your neighbour as yourself: I <i>am</i> Yahweh.  <b>Deuteronomy 15:10</b> You shalt surely give him, and your heart shall not be grieved when you givest unto him: because that for this thing Yahweh your God shall bless you in all your works, and in all that you putteth your hand unto.</p>	<p><b>Job 22:22</b> Receive, I pray you, the law from His mouth, and lay up His words in your heart.  <b>22:28</b> And whatever you decide on shall be established for you, and light shine on your ways.  <b>Isaiah 42:6</b> I Yahweh have called you in righteousness, and will hold your hand, and will keep you, and give you for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Nations;  <b>42:7</b> To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, <i>and</i> them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.  <b>Isaiah 60:1</b> Arise, shine; for your light is come, and the glory of Yahweh is risen upon you.  <b>60:2</b> For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but Yahweh shall arise upon you, and His glory shall be seen upon you.  <b>60:3</b> And the Nations shall come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your rising.</p>
7	<p><b>Honor God's Laws</b>  <b>Matthew 5:17</b> Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.  <b>5:18</b> For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.  <b>5:19</b> Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach <i>them</i>, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.</p>	<p><b>Leviticus 22:31</b> Therefore shall you keep My commandments, and do them: I <i>am</i> Yahweh.</p>	<p><b>Psalms 89:31</b> If they break My statutes, and keep not My commandments;  <b>89:32</b> Then will I visit their transgression with the rod, and their iniquity with stripes.</p>
8	<p><b>Be reconciled</b>  <b>Matthew 5:24</b> Leave there your gift before the altar, and go your way; first be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.</p>	<p><b>Leviticus 19:18</b> You shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but you shalt love your neighbour as yourself: I <i>am</i> Yahweh.</p>	<p><b>Proverbs 10:12</b> Hatred stirreth up strifes: but love covereth all sins.</p>
9	<p><b>Cut off offending members</b>  <b>Matthew 5:29</b> And if your right eye offend you, pluck it out, and cast <i>it</i> from you: for it is profitable for you that one of your members should perish, and not <i>that</i> your whole body should be cast into hell.  <b>5:30</b> And if your right hand offend you, cut it off, and cast <i>it</i> from you: for it is profitable for you that one of your members should perish, and not <i>that</i> your whole body should be cast into hell. (Matt 18:8-9; Mar 9:43-47)</p>	<p><b>Exodus 20:14</b> You shalt not commit adultery. (Deut 5:18)</p>	<p><b>Proverbs 6:32</b> <i>But</i> whoso committeth adultery with a woman lacketh understanding: he <i>that</i> doeth it destroyeth his own soul.  <b>Jeremiah 3:8</b> And I saw, when for all the causes whereby backsliding Israel committed adultery I had put her away, and given her a bill of divorce; yet her treacherous sister Judah feared not, but went and played the harlot also.</p>

10	<p><b>Swear not vainly</b>  <b>Matthew 5:34</b> But I say unto you, Swear not (vainly) at all; neither by heaven; for it is God's throne: (15:11)</p>	<p><b>Exodus 20:7</b> You shalt not take the name of Yahweh your God in vain; for Yahweh will not hold him guiltless that taketh His name in vain. (Lev 19:12; Deut 5:11, 23:21)</p>	<p><b>Ecclesiastes 5:2</b> Be not rash with your mouth, and let not your heart be hasty to utter <i>any</i> thing before God: for God <i>is</i> in heaven, and you upon earth: therefore let your words be few.</p>
11	<p><b>Go the second mile</b>  <b>Matthew 5:41</b> And whosoever shall compel you to go a mile, go with him twain.</p> <p>Christ advises, rather than to contend and quarrel with such a person, that obliges to go with him a mile, to go with him twain: His meaning is, not to dispute such a matter, though it may be somewhat laborious and disagreeable, but comply, for the sake of peace.</p>	<p><b>Exodus 21:23</b> And if <i>any</i> mischief follow, then you shalt give life for life,  <b>21:24</b> Eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot,  <b>21:25</b> Burning for burning, wound for wound, stripe for stripe.  <b>21:26</b> And if a man smite the eye of his servant, or the eye of his maid, that it perish; he shall let him go free for his eye's sake.</p>	<p><b>Proverbs 15:1</b> A soft answer turneth away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger.</p>
12	<p><b>Love your kindred enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you</b>  <b>Matthew 5:44</b> But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; (Luk 6:28)</p>	<p><b>Leviticus 19:18</b> You shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but you shalt love your neighbour as yourself: I <i>am</i> Yahweh.</p>	<p><b>Proverbs 25:21</b> If your enemy be hungry, give him bread to eat; and if he be thirsty, give him water to drink:  <b>25:22</b> For you shalt heap coals of fire upon his head, and Yahweh shall reward you.</p>
13	<p><b>Be perfect</b>  <b>Matthew 5:48</b> Be you therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.</p> <p>Not perfection in adherence to the law, which is impossible.  The perfection of the willing and sincere heart to keep His commandments.</p>	<p><b>Genesis 17:1</b> And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, Yahweh appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I <i>am</i> the Almighty God; walk before Me, and be you perfect.  <b>Deuteronomy 18:13</b> You shalt be perfect with Yahweh your God.</p>	<p><b>Genesis 6:9</b> These <i>are</i> the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man <i>and</i> perfect in his generations, <i>and</i> Noah walked with God.  <b>1Kings 8:61</b> Let your heart therefore be perfect with Yahweh our God, to walk in His statutes, and to keep His commandments, as at this day.  <b>Job 1:1</b> There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name <i>was</i> Job; and that man was perfect and upright, and one that feared God, and eschewed evil.  <b>Psalm 19:7</b> The law of Yahweh <i>is</i> perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of Yahweh <i>is</i> sure, making wise the simple.  <b>Proverbs 11:5</b> The righteousness of the perfect shall direct his way: but the wicked shall fall by his own wickedness.</p>
14	<p><b>Do not your alms before men</b>  <b>Matthew 6:1</b> Take heed that you do not your alms before men, to be seen of them: otherwise ye have no reward of your Father which is in heaven.  <b>6:2</b> Therefore when you doest alms, do not sound a trumpet before you...  <b>6:3</b> But when you doest alms, let not your left hand know what your right hand doeth:  <b>6:4</b> That your alms may be in secret: and your Father which seeth in secret Himself shall reward you openly.</p>		<p><b>Psalm 112:5</b> A good man sheweth favour, and lendeth: he will guide his affairs with discretion.  <b>112:6</b> Surely he shall not be moved for ever: the righteous shall be in everlasting remembrance.</p>

15	<p><b>Be not as the hypocrites in prayer</b>  <b>Matthew 6:5</b> And when you prayest, you shalt not be as the hypocrites <i>are</i>: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.</p>		
16	<p><b>Pray in private</b>  <b>Matthew 6:6</b> But you, when you prayest, enter into your closet, and when you hast shut your door, pray to your Father which is in secret; and your Father which seeth in secret shall reward you openly.</p>		<p><b>Daniel 6:10</b> Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.</p>
17	<p><b>Pray not like the heathen, in repetition</b>  <b>Matthew 6:7</b> But when you pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen <i>do</i>: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking.  <b>6:8</b> Be not you therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things you have need of, before you ask Him.</p>	<p><b>Exodus 20:7</b> You shalt not take the name of Yahweh your God in vain; for Yahweh will not hold him guiltless that taketh His name in vain. (Deut 5:11)</p>	<p><b>Isaiah 29:13</b> Wherefore Yahweh said, Forasmuch as this people draw near <i>Me</i> with their mouth, and with their lips do honour Me, but have removed their heart far from Me, and their fear toward Me is taught by the precept of men (<i>without any regard for its meaning</i>):  Rote: proceeding mechanically and repetitiously.</p>
18	<p><b>Don't be like the hypocrites in fasting</b>  <b>Matthew 6:16</b> Moreover when you fast, be not, as the hypocrites, of a sad countenance: for they disfigure their faces, that they may appear unto men to fast. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.</p>		<p><b>Isaiah 58:4</b> Behold, you fast for strife and debate, and to smite with the fist of wickedness: you shall not fast as <i>you do this</i> day, to make your voice to be heard on high.</p>
19	<p><b>Lay up treasures in heaven</b>  <b>Matthew 6:19</b> Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal:  <b>6:20</b> But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:  <b>6:21</b> For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also. (Luk 12:33-34)</p>	<p><b>Leviticus 19:18</b> You shall not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but you shalt love your neighbour as yourself: I <i>am</i> Yahweh.</p>	<p><b>Psalms 85:11</b> Truth shall spring out of the earth; and righteousness shall look down from heaven.  <b>Proverbs 19:17</b> He that hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto Yahweh; and that which he hath given will He pay him again.  <b>Isaiah 55:2</b> Wherefore do you spend money for <i>that which is</i> not bread? and your labour for <i>that which</i> satisfieth not? hearken diligently unto Me, and eat you <i>that which is</i> good, and let your soul delight itself in fatness.</p>
20	<p><b>Take no thought for your life</b>  <b>Matthew 6:25</b> Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what you shall eat, or what you shall drink; nor yet for your body, what you shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment? (Luk 12:22-30)  <b>6:31</b> Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? (Luk 12:29)</p>	<p><b>Deuteronomy 8:9</b> A land wherein you shalt eat bread without scarceness, you shalt not lack any <i>thing</i> in it; a land whose stones <i>are</i> iron, and out of whose hills thou mayest dig brass.  <b>8:6</b> Therefore you shalt keep the commandments of Yahweh your God, to walk in His ways, and to fear Him.</p>	<p><b>Psalms 23:1</b> Yahweh <i>is</i> my shepherd; I shall not lack.  <b>Psalms 78:20</b> Behold, He smote the rock, that the waters gushed out, and the streams overflowed; can He give bread also? can He provide flesh for His people?  <b>Psalms 147:9</b> He giveth to the beast his food, <i>and</i> to the young ravens which cry.  <b>Proverbs 10:3</b> Yahweh will not</p>

			suffer the soul of the righteous to go hungry: but He casteth away the substance of the wicked. <b>Sirach 34:1</b> Watching for riches consumeth the flesh, and the care thereof driveth away sleep.
21	<b>Seek first the kingdom of God</b> <b>Matthew 6:33</b> But seek you first the kingdom of God, and His righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. (Luk 12:31)	<b>Deuteronomy 4:29</b> But if from thence you shalt seek Yahweh your God, you shalt find <i>Him</i> , if you seek Him with all your heart and with all your soul. <b>4:31</b> (For Yahweh your God <i>is</i> a merciful God;) He will not forsake you, neither destroy you, nor forget the covenant of your fathers which He sware unto them.	<b>Hosea 10:12</b> Sow to yourselves in righteousness, reap in mercy; break up your fallow ground: for <i>it is</i> time to seek Yahweh, till He come and rain righteousness upon you.
22	<b>Judge (condemn) not</b> <b>Matthew 7:1</b> Judge (condemn) not, that you be not judged (condemned). <b>7:2</b> For with what judgment you judge, you shall be judged: and with what measure you mete, it shall be measured to you again.	<b>Leviticus 19:15</b> You shall do no unrighteousness in judgment: you shalt not respect the person of the poor, nor honour the person of the mighty: <i>but</i> in righteousness shalt you judge your neighbour.	<b>2Chronicles 19:6</b> And (Jeshoshaphat) said to the judges, Take heed what you do: for you judge not for man, but for Yahweh, who <i>is</i> with you in the judgment.
23	<b>Cast the beam out of your own eye</b> <b>Matthew 7:5</b> You hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of your own eye; and then shalt you see clearly to cast out the mote out of your brother's eye. (Luk 6:42)		<b>Proverbs 3:7</b> Be not wise in your own eyes: fear Yahweh, and depart from evil. <b>Proverbs 11:9</b> A hypocrite with <i>his</i> mouth destroyeth his neighbour: but through knowledge shall the just be delivered. <b>Isaiah 5:21</b> Woe unto <i>them that are</i> wise in their own eyes, and prudent in their own sight! <b>Ezekiel 33:31</b> And they come unto you as the people cometh, and they sit before you <i>as</i> My people, and they hear your words, but they will not do them: for with their mouth they shew much love, <i>but</i> their heart goeth after their covetousness.
24	<b>Give not holy things unto dogs and swine</b> <b>Matthew 7:6</b> Give not that which is holy unto the dogs, neither cast you your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn again and rend you.	<b>Exodus 23:32</b> You shalt make no covenant with them, nor with their gods. (Deut 7:2) <b>Deuteronomy 23:2</b> A bastard shall not enter into the congregation of Yahweh; even to his tenth generation shall he not enter into the congregation of Yahweh.	<b>Ezra 9:12</b> Now therefore give not your daughters unto their sons, neither take their daughters unto your sons, nor seek their peace or their wealth for ever: <b>Ezekiel 22:8</b> You hast despised My holy things, and hast profaned My sabbaths.
25	<b>Ask, seek, knock</b> <b>Matthew 7:7</b> Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and you shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: <b>7:8</b> For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.	<b>Deuteronomy 32:7</b> Remember the days of old, consider the years of many generations: ask your father, and he will shew you; your elders, and they will tell you.	<b>1Kings 3:5</b> In Gibeon Yahweh appeared to Solomon in a dream by night: and God said, Ask what I shall give you. (2Chr 1:7) <b>Proverbs 8:17</b> I love them that love Me; and those that seek Me early shall find Me. <b>Jeremiah 6:16</b> Thus saith Yahweh, Stand you in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where <i>is</i> the good way,

			<p>and walk therein, and you shall find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk <i>therein</i>.</p> <p><b>Jeremiah 29:13</b> And you shall seek Me, and find <i>Me</i>, when you shall search for Me with all your heart.</p> <p><b>Zechariah 10:1</b> Ask you of Yahweh rain in the time of the latter rain; <i>so</i> Yahweh shall make bright clouds, and give them showers of rain, to every one grass in the field.</p>
26	<p><b>Do unto others</b>  <b>Matthew 7:12</b> Therefore all things whatsoever you would that men should do to you, do you even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets. (Luk 6:31)</p>	<p><b>Leviticus 19:18</b> ...but you shalt love your neighbour as yourself: I <i>am</i> Yahweh.</p> <p><b>Deuteronomy 19:19</b> Then shall you do unto him, as he had thought to have done unto his brother: so shalt you put the evil away from among you.</p>	
27	<p><b>Choose the narrow way</b>  <b>Matthew 7:13</b> Enter you in at the strait gate: for wide <i>is</i> the gate, and broad <i>is</i> the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:  <b>7:14</b> Because strait <i>is</i> the gate, and narrow <i>is</i> the way, which leadeth unto life, and few there be that find it.</p>	<p><b>Deuteronomy 30:15</b> See, I have set before you this day life and good, and death and evil;  <b>30:16</b> In that I command you this day to love Yahweh your God, to walk in His ways, and to keep His commandments and His statutes and His judgments, that you mayest live and multiply:  <b>30:19</b> I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, <i>that</i> I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both you and your seed may live:</p>	<p><b>Joshua 24:15</b> ... choose you this day whom you will serve;  <b>Psalms 25:12</b> What man <i>is</i> he that feareth Yahweh? Him shall He teach in the way <i>that</i> he shall choose.</p> <p><b>IEsdras 7:6</b> Another example: There is a city built and set on a plain, and it is full of all good things;  <b>7</b> but the entrance to it is narrow and set in a precipitous place, so that there is fire on the right hand and deep water on the left;  <b>8</b> and there is only one path lying between them, that is, between the fire and the water, so that only one man can walk upon that path.  <b>9</b> If now that city is given to a man for an inheritance, how will the heir receive his inheritance unless he passes through the danger set before him?"  <b>10</b> I said, "He cannot, master." And he said to me, "So also is Israel's portion."  <b>11</b> For I made the world for their sake, and when Adam transgressed My statutes, what had been made was judged.  <b>12</b> And so the entrances of <u>this world were made narrow</u> and sorrowful and toilsome; they are few and evil, full of dangers and involved in great hardships.  <b>13</b> But the entrances of the greater world are broad and safe, and yield the fruit of immortality.  <b>14</b> <u>Therefore unless the living</u></p>

28	<p><b>Beware of false prophets/preachers</b>  <b>Matthew 7:15</b> Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.</p>	<p><b>Deuteronomy 13:3</b> You shalt not hearken unto the words of that (false) prophet, or that dreamer of dreams: for Yahweh your God proveth you, to know whether you love Yahweh your God with all your heart and with all your soul.</p>	<p><b>Psalms 119:104</b> Through Your precepts I get understanding: therefore I hate every false way.  <b>Jeremiah 5:31</b> The prophets prophesy falsely, and the priests bear rule by their means; and My people love <i>to have it</i> so: and what will you do in the end thereof?  <b>Jeremiah 14:14</b> Then Yahweh said unto me, The prophets prophesy lies in My name: I sent them not, neither have I commanded them, neither spake unto them: they prophesy unto you a false vision and divination, and a thing of nought, and the deceit of their heart.  <b>Lamentation 2:14</b> Your prophets have seen vain and foolish things for you: and they have not discovered your iniquity, to turn away your captivity; but have seen for you false burdens and causes of banishment.</p>
29	<p><b>Learn what mercy means</b>  <b>Matthew 9:12</b> But when Jesus heard <i>that</i>, He said unto them, <b>They that be whole need not a physician, but they that are sick.</b>  <b>9:13</b> But go you and learn what <i>that</i> meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.</p>	<p><b>Exodus 20:6</b> And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love Me, and keep My commandments. So we see that Jesus Christ taught from the Torah of Moses. Out of these 85 commandments, at least 68 of them are from the Law of Moses. The few other ones were about prayer, and to beware of the Pharisees and their doctrines and hypocrisy.

The law was not 'done away with'.

The ceremonial ordinances, rituals, and sacrifices were what was 'done away with'. Notice that Jesus did not speak about performing rituals or sacrifices.

He spoke mainly about repentance and seeking first the kingdom of God. He commanded to sin no more. He taught to forgive and have mercy. He taught to maintain good works.

The moral precepts of the Torah are a declaration of God's will, and they are a copy of His nature, and stamped with His authority.

Torah means 'instruction' and 'teaching'. The whole Bible is Torah.

**Proverbs 6:23** For the commandment *is* a lamp; and the law *is* light; and reproofs of instruction *are* the way of life:

**2Timothy 3:16** All scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

**3:17** That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works.

The only Scriptures at that time was the OT, the law, and the prophets.

Don't ever let anyone convince you that the law was 'done away with'. Jesus came to magnify the law and make it honourable. We glorify the Father when we keep and follow His laws.
